Beta Delta will be celebrating its 100th birthday on Saturday, October 14, 2006 at the Double Tree Hotel (formerly The Edgewater) in Missoula. Grand Consul Bob Jones will be in attendance as well as other Sigma Chi dignitaries, brothers and sweethearts. Please add this "don't miss" event into your long range plans.

NEWS FROM BETA DELTA HOUSE CORPORATION

Five years ago, we set out on an ambitious renovation program to refurbish The House. We are now 85% complete. This past year, we completed the following:

Electrical. A new underground power supply line was laid to Back Shack.

Active Chapter Room. Floor and benches refinished (by Actives at their expense).

Tube Room. Ceiling, walls and floor refinished (by Actives at their expense).

Shower Repairs. Long standing leaks and poor water pressure were resolved by installing new shower controls.

Pledge Room. New ceiling and light fixture

Water Supply Valve Replacement. The underground curb valve was replaced.

Landscape Project. Alums and actives worked together in August 2005 to accomplish a major overhaul of the landscaping including a new underground sprinkler system, several tree removals and installation of new landscaping in the front and side yard.

WORK STILL TO DO

Even though much has been accomplished over the past five years, there is much still to do. Here is our Yet To Do List:

Fire Safety System. The Fire Marshall has put increasing pressure on us for fire safety. Slant Shack, Classroom and FUBAR have been discontinued as bedroom due to lack of egress windows. Plans are being made to install a fire sprinkler system.

Bedrooms Refurbish with wall and trim repair, paint, light fixtures, new carpet and window treatments.

2nd & 3rd Floor Hallways Refurbish with wall repair, paint and carpet.

Back Shack Install one hour fire wall and door on garage side.

Ski Shack Repair cracked foundation, brick and mortar; install new roof and

gutters.

Fireplaces Repair crumbled firebrick and floor tile; repair copper hoods; install custom fit doors/screens.

Window Treatments 1st Floor Install new draperies and/or blinds.

Archive Storage Room Refurbish to allow better storage, temperature and moisture control.

Library Renovation Refinish walls and floor; repair stain glass windows; repair lighting.

The goal is to have all work completed for Beta Delta's 100th Anniversary in 2006. As you can see, there is still much to do but we will continue as long as financial support continues. For more on the specifics, read on...

FUNDRAISER AT \$300,192

Our capital fundraiser is 85.77% "there" with 307 brothers contributing. For the names, see www.betadelta-sigmachi.org "Giving Back" List of Contributors.

There are 1167 living Beta Delta Sigma Chis. That leaves 860 of you that have not yet contributed. Why not step up to the plate now? We have only \$49,808 more to go to reach our goal of \$350,000. SCHOLARSHIP ENDOWMENT

The UM Foundation manages \$100,000 of Beta Delta's Scholarship Endowment. In addition, the endowment owns a \$50,000 mortgage note on 1110 Gerald generating a higher interest rate. The goal of the scholarship fund is to build a \$1,000,000 endowment by the year 2012 with the generous support of alumni brothers and friends.

The Beta Delta house corporation (Sigma Chi Building Foundation) is approved by the IRS as a 501(c)(3) charitable foundation and donations are tax deductible.
